

Styling idea

Pay attention to the colour of the wall: ideally, the wall colour should contrast with the different shades of the pieces of leaf art. White or soft grey walls make an ideal backdrop for the natural tones of the leaves, but a matching shade can also have a wonderfully subtle or striking effect.



This is paper cutting at its finest!

To cut these delicate shapes, you need to take some time to sit down and concentrate. Once you are done, putting the leaves in beautiful frames and hanging them in an artistic arrangement on the wall will be the icing on the cake. Mix and match frames

of different shapes and sizes and fix one or more leaves to a nice piece of wood to create a vibrant display. Be very careful not to cut too far, especially when cutting the fern leaf, or you may end up with a part of your leaf missing.
